Danville, IL – The third game of the 2018 NJCAA Division II Men's Basketball tournament featured the top-seed Triton College and 16-seed Ulster County Community College.

Alondes Williams opened up the game with a three pointer, which would be the theme of the half for the Trojans. Williams knocked down his third three-pointer of the half with 14:02 left to give Triton a 18-5 lead heading into the first media timeout.

In the next two minutes, two more Trojans would knock down threes, extending the lead to 24-six with 12 minutes to go in the half.

Eight threes from the Trojans in the first half paced Triton. Two stretches of five-plus minute scoring droughts put Ulster County in a bind and by the end of the half, the Trojans led the Senators, 53-22.

But Triton was too much, using a 25-6 run to blow the game open, 95-52.

Triton expanded their lead to 48, and would end the game at that margin, winning 107-59.
